Re: MSDS Polyethersulfone (PES) Membranes

This letter is in response to your request for an MSDS for PES membranes.

Please be advised that these membranes do not contain any hazardous chemicals. The membranes may be classified as articles under OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard (ref: 29 CFR 1910.1200(c)) and as such are exempt from the requirement for an MSDS under the standard. The OSHA standard defines an article as a manufactured item: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to, a hazardous chemical under normal conditions.
